Seaview High School students are expected to bring their own device to enable best practice in teaching and learning. After extensive consultation, we believe we have identified a range of devices that will best support both our students with their learning and our teachers in the classroom.

For students in Years 10 to 12, our digital learning program encourages families to choose from a selection of preferred laptops. The laptop is purchased by the parent/caregiver and belongs to the student from the outset. For access to the school network, the device and its software needs meet minimum specifications, and comply with the school's Digital Learning Policy.


