

SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY



The Governing Council has endorsed the following Seaview High School uniform. The uniform is based on the colours of navy blue, burgundy and white. The uniform distinguishes the student as a Seaview High school student, and it is also an identifying marker for security reasons. Students are able to choose from the items listed on the following page. The uniform items will be reviewed as required by a committee of Governing Council, students and staff to ensure they are adequate to the needs of the students.

The requirement to wear the uniform

The Seaview High School uniform is to be worn by all students during the school day, including to and from school, and whilst representing the school in out-of-hours, off-campus events and excursions. The sports uniform is to be worn when involved in sporting activities.

Uniform items for specialist program may only be worn by students when involved in activities associated with the specialist program. The Special Interest Sports and/or High Performance Tennis program uniforms may only be worn whilst involved in the program lessons, either at school or in competition. It is the responsibility of the parent/caregiver to ensure their children are in the uniform each day.

Purchase of the uniform

The contracted uniform supplier for the majority of the uniform is determined by a Department for Education tender process. A Uniform Shop, currently run by Belgravia Sports, is open at Seaview High School one day per week or by appointment.

Parents will be supplied with the uniform list annually. This list will include the updated costs of items. Where the uniform costs cause financial hardship, arrangements will be made to assist the family, so that the student does not suffer any embarrassment from non-compliance with the policy. Action to support the family may include: time payment, the supply of the uniform from a discretionary fund, the loan of articles or the donation of good quality, clean used items. A parent should contact the Front Office or school counsellor if assistance is required.

Other school requirements - Identification and security

All students are required to carry their student ID card with them at school. If a teacher asks for the ID card the student will politely hand it to the teacher for checking. No parent or visitor, who is not an enrolled student of the school, is permitted to enter the school grounds without applying for a visitor's badge from the school Front Office.

Garments worn under clothing

Garments worn under outer uniform clothing must comply with the school colours and not be visible.

Nail Varnish, Makeup

Nails must be kept to a reasonable length and artificial nails are not recommended due to health and safety risk. Shades of pink or natural tones nail varnish only are acceptable. Students who choose to wear make-up should wear only neutral and natural tones.

Piercing and Facial Jewellery

Students are permitted to wear discrete ear rings in one or both ears and a discrete nose stud. Jewellery should be safe and unobtrusive. Other facial and visible body piercing/s are not acceptable.

Consequences for not following requirements

Students who do not abide by this policy will be directed to the Principal. Parents will be contacted if non-compliance continues. Where safety issues arise from a breach of this policy:

- students will be excluded from activities where the breach could create an unsafe situation

In these instances parents will be contacted.

GENERAL UNIFORM ITEMS

ITEM	DESCRIPTION/COMMENT
White Shirt (Long or Short Sleeve)	With SHS logo. White or skin tone undergarments only.
Polo Shirt	SHS logo. Navy blue with white stripe on collar.
Outerwear	SHS logo. Plain navy blue with maroon inner collar.
Woollen Jumper	Maroon V-neck woollen jumper
Trousers	Navy blue plain trousers with drawstring.
Bootleg pants	Plain navy blue with zip. Either hipster or waisted.
Summer Dress	SHS tartan. Skirt must be no longer than midway between ankle and knee and no higher than midway between knee and thigh.
Skirt	SHS tartan skirt. Skirt must be no longer than midway between ankle and knee and no higher than midway between knee and thigh.
Stockings	Navy blue, black or skin tone only.
Shorts	Navy blue plain with drawstring. Shorts must be above the knee but no higher than midway between knee and thigh.
School tie	With white shirt only.
Year 12 jumper	As designed by graduating class. To be only worn by Year 12 class.
Winter Scarf	Navy blue with SHS Logo.
Belts	Black or navy blue, plain only.

GENERAL SPORTS UNIFORM

To be worn for physical education lessons ONLY. Cannot be worn as a general uniform.

ITEM	DESCRIPTION/COMMENT
Polo Shirt	With logo. Maroon with white side panels
Sport Shorts	With logo. Navy
Tracksuit Pants	With logo. Navy blue with elastic waist.
Special Sports Team Uniform	As per sports team. Shirt will be loaned to students through the sports department.
Sun-safe Hat	SHS hat or plain navy blue.

SPECIALISED UNIFORM ITEMS

To be worn for special interest program lessons ONLY. Cannot be worn as a general uniform.

ITEM	DESCRIPTION/COMMENT
Special Interest Sports	As per the sports program approved by Governing Council.
High Performance Tennis	As per the tennis program approved by Governing Council.
Dance Tops	As per the relevant dance activity.
Shoes – General Uniform	Black leather or leather-look buckle or lace up shoes only. Enclosed footwear of sturdy design only for H&S reasons.
Shoes – Sport	Sport shoes appropriate for physical activities only.
