Dear parent/caregiver,

Seaview High School students are encouraged to bring their own device to enable best practice in teaching and learning.

Our Digital Learning Program includes the use of iPads for students in Middle School (Years 7 to 9), and a selection of preferred laptops for students in Senior School (Years 10 to 12). The program is a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) program, which means the iPad and laptop are purchased by the parent/caregiver and belong to the student from the outset.

Seaview, in partnership with IT solutions company CompNow, has established a purchasing portal with highly competitive iPad prices. ***We highly recommend that you take advantage of these prices by purchasing your iPad through the portal.***

If you already own an iPad, please note that the iPad must be able to run at least iOS 13 and the iPad mini is not recommended.
