Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Today the Premier announced a 7-day state-wide lockdown starting at 6.00pm tonight (Tuesday 20 July 2021).

All students and staff have been asked to take home their devices and any resources they need to continue their learning from home.

Only the children of essential workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend Seaview High School from tomorrow, **Wednesday 21 July**, which is considered a student free day, allowing teachers time to prepare for online learning. A small team of staff will be onsite tomorrow to provide supervision, not a learning program, for those children who need to attend.

From **Thursday 22 July**, all students will engage in online learning via DAYMAP. Information about how to access lessons on DAYMAP and expectations for each day will be sent via DAYMAP and Learnlink email to all students tomorrow.

We will keep you updated via email, the school website and Facebook, as we navigate our way through the new COVID-19 Directions.
