All students are expected to wear the Seaview High School uniform. This decision is affirmed by the Governing Council, Principal and Staff.

## Items of Uniform

### General Items

- Zip collar windcheater with logo
- Soft shell jacket with logo
- Rugby top with logo
- Navy polo top with logo
- Burgundy V neck woollen jumper
- White shirt
- Check dress (no more than 10cm above the knee)
- Tartan skirt (no more than 10cm above the knee)
- Loose fit navy school pants or shorts (track pants, cargo pants and leggings are not permitted)
- Fitted navy school pants or shorts (track pants, cargo pants and leggings are not permitted)
- Navy or black opaque stockings with the winter skirt
- Plain black or white socks (no visible brands)
- School cap or bucket hat

### Uniform for Student Ambassadors, including SRC

- Burgundy V neck woollen jumper
- White shirt
- Tartan skirt (no more than 10cm above the knee)
- Navy school pants or shorts (track pants, cargo pants and leggings are not permitted)
- Navy or black opaque tights or plain white socks





## Footwear requirements for all students

Plain black, flat soled, leather (or vinyl) lace-up enclosed school shoes or plain black, flat-soled, leather Mary Jane or t-bar shoes.

**Unacceptable Footwear:** Slip on black shoes with exposed tops and shoes made with canvas or fabric due to WH&S regulations.

## Physical Education Uniform

- PE sports shorts with logo
- PE track pants with logo
- Burgundy PE polo top with logo
- Bucket hat with logo
- Appropriate sporting footwear

Students change into the Physical Education uniform at the beginning of the PE lesson. On completion of the PE lesson students are required to change back into their school uniform.





## Special Interest Uniform

- Tennis or SIS shorts with logo
- Tennis or SIS polo with logo
- Tennis or SIS track pant with logo
- Bucket hat with logo
- Appropriate sporting footwear

## Protective Clothing

At Seaview High School we provide a safe learning environment and adhere to safety guidelines specified by Department for Education, SafeWork SA and the Work Health & Safety Act.

Guidelines regarding clothing, footwear and eye protection are explained to students attending practical courses.

It is expected hats are worn for sun protection. Within buildings, hats are to be removed.

## Jewellery and Make-Up

Make-up and jewellery are not considered part of the school uniform.

Students must be in full school uniform to attend classes and while travelling to and from school.

## SPECIAL INTEREST SPORT/TENNIS UNIFORM POLICY

The Special Interest Sports and Tennis uniform may **ONLY** be worn by students who have met the criteria for selection into the Special Interest Sport/ Tennis program/s and **ONLY** during SIS Sports or Tennis classes. **Students must change into their Special Interest Sport Uniform just prior to their Special Interest or Tennis class and change back into their regular uniform for the rest of the day.**

Students purchase the following **COMPULSORY ITEMS** from the Uniform Shop:

- Seaview High School SIS/Tennis shirt
- Seaview HS SIS/Tennis shorts
- SIS track pants
- Seaview HS SIS embroidered jacket



The Seaview High School 'Embossed' zip collar windcheater is not a part of the SIS/Tennis uniform and is not to be worn with the track suit or shorts.

Shoes – it is an essential requirement that shoes worn provide suitable protection and support and meet the Health and Safety needs of the school.

It is preferred that SIS/Tennis shoes are predominantly black, navy or white, with no fluoro colours.

If the sports shoe does not meet the WH&S standards students will need to wear school shoes and change into sports shoes for SIS/Tennis classes.

# SCHOOL DRESS CODE

## **Rationale:**

The Seaview High School Uniform is approved by the Seaview High School Governing Council and applies to all students. It is based on the school colours of navy blue, burgundy and white.

The Uniform identifies students as belonging to the Seaview High School community and reflects the values and expectations of our school. The uniform is determined by Governing Council, after consultation with the school community and designed to be inclusive, provide choice for a variety of weather conditions and support the safety and wellbeing of our students.

Seaview High School's Uniform Policy is consistent with the Department for Education's Dress Code Policy and guided by our school values: **Respect, Empathy, Resilience and Integrity**. Students are expected to uphold these values and wear the school uniform as proud members of their community.

## **Aims:**

- to promote a sense of pride and belonging to the school
- to be inclusive and provide choice
- to promote safety and security within the school grounds by ensuring students are readily identifiable

## **Wearing School Uniform:**

It is an expectation that all students wear the approved uniform at all times, including when travelling to and from school and when representing the school in out-of-hours activities and/or off campus events and excursions.

The Seaview High School uniform is available from the contracted supplier and provides a convenient, quality and value for money service to the school community. Families do have the option to purchase items from other suppliers, providing they are exactly the same as the items identified within the school's uniform policy. For matters relating to uniform purchase, financial hardship, cultural or religious needs, please contact a member of the school executive leadership team.

A complete list of approved uniform items is available on the school's website at [www.seaviewhs.sa.edu.au](http://www.seaviewhs.sa.edu.au). We encourage labelling items with the student's name to aid recovery if items are lost.

**Please note:** Uniform items for PE are only worn by students during those lessons. On the completion of the lesson students must change into the approved school uniform.

The Special Interest Program uniforms may only be worn by students enrolled in the program and whilst involved in the program lessons, either at school or in competition.

## **Health and Safety:**

Guidelines regarding clothing, footwear and nail length are aligned to the safety guidelines specified by the Department for Education, Department of Industry and the Work, Health and Safety Act.

Shoes are required to be all black, enclosed, leather or leather-look school shoes, with a defined low heel. These styles comply with the WHS safety requirements to access all learning spaces within the school.

Nails are expected to be a reasonable length, and artificial nails are not recommended, due to health and safety risk.



Seaview High School acknowledges that exposure to the sun causes damage and for this reason a hat is included in the school uniform and sports uniform. Students are encouraged to wear the school hat when participating in outdoor activities, PE, SIS, Tennis and School Sport.

### **Miscellaneous:**

Discrete jewellery that ensures the personal safety of students is acceptable. The school understands that jewellery of cultural significance or sentimental value are important to some students and these can be worn under the school uniform, providing they are not visible.

Medic Alert jewellery is exempted.

Students who choose to wear make-up should wear neutral and natural tones. Additional clothing items worn under the uniform must not be visible.

### **Non Compliance:**

Students who are not in uniform will be offered a change of clothing or sent home to change. Non-compliance is dealt with through the Behaviour Support Process.

### **Evaluation:**

Uniform items are reviewed as required by a committee of Governing Council, students and staff to ensure they remain adequate to the needs of the students. This policy will be reviewed regularly in consultation with the whole school community.
