- Complete the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE)
- Complete the required Certificate II or III course
- Complete the specified Stage 2 subjects (as detailed within) at a C+ grade or higher.
- **Meet any course specific entry requirements as listed on the relevant course webpage (e.g. pre-requisites, audition, portfolio, etc).**

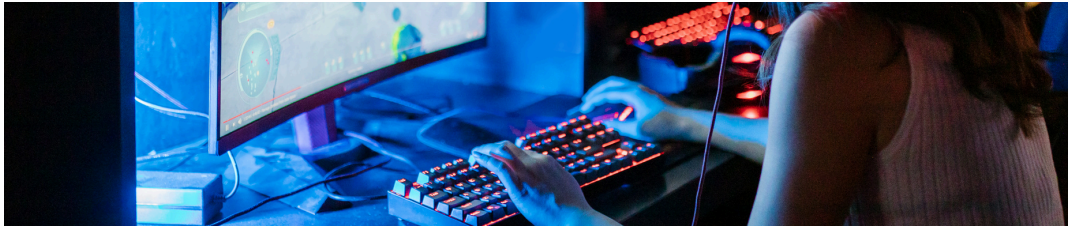

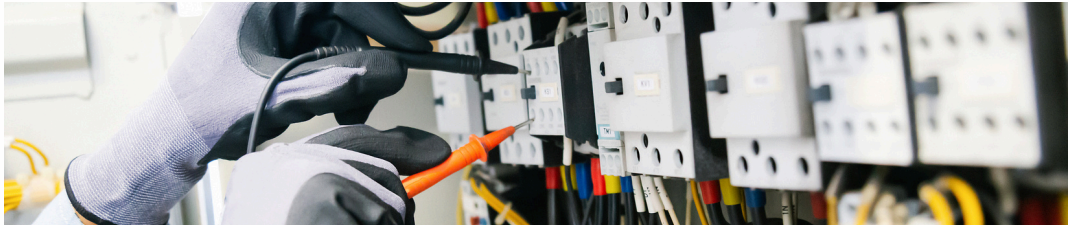
