

New Daymap App for Parents → “Daymap Companion”

Daymap have released their new and improved app, Daymap Companion. The new app offers a more user friendly and streamlined experience for parents, with the added benefit of being able to manage all your children in the one place (even if they are at different schools).



This app is available for iPhones, iPads, Android devices and on PCs. If you already have the Daymap App (Daymap Connect or Daymap Mobile), you may see a pop up prompting you to switch to Companion. We encourage all parents to do this as soon as possible, as older versions of the app will no longer feature updates moving forward.

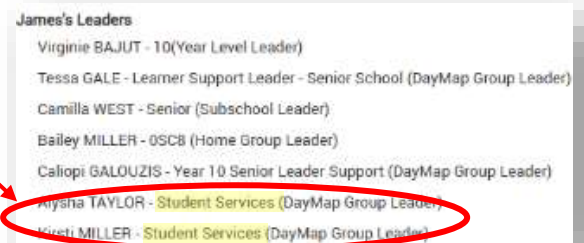

Communicating with Teachers via Daymap

In response to parent feedback, Daymap has now streamlined how parents can communicate with teachers at their child’s school. When messaging, you will now see a list of all relevant teachers and leaders that you can select to message. This does mean, however, that parents are no longer able to message teachers or staff who are not directly aligned to their child.

If you need to contact a teacher who is not on the list, please do one of the following:

1. Select one of the “Student Services” team that are listed under “Leaders” for any of your children. They will pass on your message to the relevant teacher (please ensure you indicate which teacher you are trying to reach)



2. Please email dl.0893.studentservices@schools.sa.edu.au with your message, and they will ensure that it is passed on to the relevant teacher.

Notifications re Upcoming or Overdue Assessment Tasks

Daymap will now automatically notify both students and parents of upcoming due dates (24 hours prior), or overdue work via Daymap message. These notifications will be sent via Daymap message; parents are encouraged to make sure they have notifications enabled for the Daymap app.

If you believe your child has submitted work that is showing as overdue, please contact their teacher via Daymap message.
