

Seaview High School ICT, Mobile Device and BYOD user agreement

Seaview High School is dedicated to fostering a safe learning environment for all students. This user agreement outlines the appropriate use of ICT resources, mobile devices and BYODs (Bring Your Own Device) to ensure a safe, secure and productive educational setting.

All students agree to ICT acceptable use:

- Agrees to use their assigned network account only
- Will not impersonate another student, device or network
- Will protect their personal information by not sharing usernames, logins or passwords
- Will not attempt to access inappropriate material or content
- Will respect copyright laws
- Will not conduct illegal downloads
- Maintain respectful online communication and refrain from harassment, including:
 - Cyberbullying, spreading harmful content, or engaging in disrespectful communication
 - Any instances of online bullying or harassment should be reported immediately to staff
- Report any suspicious activity or policy violations
- Abide by state and federal laws
- Respect individuals' privacy by obtaining consent before capturing media
- I will respect all school ICE equipment and services and will treat devices with care including:
 - Not intentionally disrupting the running of any school ICT system
 - Not attempting to hack or gain unauthorised access to any system
 - Reporting any breakages/damage to staff

Mobile Phones and Personal Electronic Devices in alignment with South Australian government regulations:

- Mobile phone and personal electronic device use is prohibited on school grounds
- All students devices are OFF and AWAY on school grounds
- YONDR pouches provide secure storage for devices
- Students are responsible for maintaining their YONDR pouches
- Use of personal hotspots, or any internet connection not provided by the school, is not permitted

Acceptable iPad and laptop use:

- Students will arrive to school with their device fully charged and ready to use
- Students are expected to take their device to all lessons unless otherwise instructed
- SIM cards must be removed from iPads

Non-compliance will be addressed through Seaview High School's Behaviour Support process.

By adhering to these policies, Seaview High School aims to create a safe and conducive learning environment where technology is used responsibly to enhance educational outcomes.
